IEI developed a mobile point-of-care medical certified panel PC powered by hot-swappable batteries to keep EMR in continuous use.





 POCm-DOCKING: battery charging docking for POCm-W22C/W24C's battery






POCm-W22C-ULT3-i5/PC

- · IP65 front panel and anti-bacteria housing for easy cleaning






POCm-DOCKING-6BAY

- Supports 6 x batteries charging at the same time






Remote real-time battery monitoring


